Andy won both the 200-yard individual medley (2:01.33) and the 200-yard butterfly (2:01.38) at the Henry Kumpf Invitational, hosted by Rensselaer. The Red Dragons finished third at the seven-team meet. Chevalier won three individual events earlier in the week in Cortland's 120-97 dual victory over Oneonta. He won both the 500-yard freestyle (5:01.90) and 1,000-yard freestyle (10:28.57) in addition to the 400-yard individual medley (4:29.19).

In just her second collegiate meet, Ashleigh set a new school record and provisionally qualified for the NCAA Division III Indoor Track and Field Championships in the triple jump. She finished third in the event at the NYC Collegiate Opener with her distance of 36' 11.25". The previous school mark was 36' 10.5" by Jennifer Sponenberg in 1993. Rajkowski also tied for 10th and was the top Division III finisher in the long jump at 16' 4.25".
