Nick finished second in the 55-meter dash at the NCAA Division III Men's Indoor Track and Field Championships Friday and Saturday in Bloomington, Ill. Wetherby turned in a personal-best time of 6.41 seconds in the preliminaries, then beat that with his time of 6.39 seconds in the finals. The winning time was 6.35 seconds. Cortland tied for 23rd in the final team standings. Wetherby was the 100-meter dash champ at last year's NCAA Div. III Outdoor Championships.

Ali recorded eight goals and one assist as nationally 18th-ranked Cortland opened the season with two wins in West Palm Beach, Florida. She scored four goals and picked up three ground balls in the Red Dragons' 15-2 win over Wittenberg (Ohio) on Tuesday. Three days later, Bourgal scored four times, assisted on a goal and grabbed four ground balls as Cortland defeated 14th-ranked and previously unbeaten Wesleyan University (Conn.), 13-8.
