Mike recorded eight goals, two assists and 19 ground balls and won 21-of-28 faceoffs in two victories for the Red Dragons. He scored four goals, assisted on two others and won 12-of-13 faceoffs in a 24-4 win vs. Oswego, then scored four times and grabbed 11 ground balls in an 18-6 win at Oneonta. Abbott was named both the SUNYAC and ECAC Division III Upstate N.Y. Men's Lacrosse Player of the Week. He has 22 goals and eight assists through 11 games.

Christina was named the ECAC Division III Women's "Field Athlete of the Week" after automatically qualifying for the NCAA Division III Championships in the heptathlon at the Bucknell Univ. Bison Outdoor Classic. She finished third at the meet with a score of 4,596 points, which included second-place efforts in the 100-meter hurdles (14.49) and long jump (17' 11.5") and third-place showings in the 200-meter dash (26.35) and high jump (5' 0.25").
