Nick provisionally qualified for the NCAA Division III Outdoor Championships and set meet records in both the 100-meter and 200-meter dashes at the SUNYAC Championship meet. The ECAC Div. III Track Athlete of the Week repeated as champion in both events, covering the 100 in 10.61 seconds and the 200 in a personal-best 21.56 seconds. Wetherby also anchored the winning 4x100-meter relay (42.50). Cortland won its second straight league title.

Christina was the top scorer at the SUNYAC Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championships. She repeated as champion in the 100-meter hurdles (14.62) and won the long jump (18' 3"), both with NCAA Div. III Championship provisional qualifying performances. Acquaviva was also third in the 200-meter dash (25.94) and fourth in the high jump (4' 10.5"), and she was part of a second-place 4x100-meter relay (49.86). Cortland finished third at the meet.
