## 2005 USILA Division I Men's Lacrosse North-South Senior All-Star Game

Saturday, June 11, 2005; SUNY Cortland Stadium Complex; Cortland, N.Y.

### FINAL SCORE: South 14, North 11

CORTLAND, N.Y. – Bucknell University attackman **Chris Cara (Medford, NY)** scored six goals and earned game Most Valuable Player honors as the South defeated the North, 14-11, in the 2005 United States Intercollegiate Lacrosse Association (USILA) Division I Men's Lacrosse North-South Senior All-Star Game at the SUNY Cortland Stadium Complex.

Virginia Military Institute attackman **Leo McInerney (Marcellus, NY)** recorded two goals and an assist and midfielder **Ian Healy (Great Falls, VA)** of the University of Maryland added two goals for the South. Cara scored the first two goals, followed by a goal from Georgetown University midfielder **Andrew Corno (Bethesda, MD)**, to give the South a 3-0 lead 8:38 into the game and they never trailed.

Princeton University attackman **Jason Doneger (Hewlett, NY)** led the North with four goals. Attackman **Jeff Zywicki (Ottawa, ONT)** of the University of Massachusetts scored three goals, while attackman **Matt Brown (Burnaby, BC)** of the University of Denver and midfielder **Thomas Zummo (Islip, NY)** of Div. II New York Tech each finished with two goals and two assists.

Duke University's **Aaron Fenton (Wynnewood, PA)** started in goal for the South and stopped seven of the nine shots on goal he faced in 20:27 of action. Towson University's **Reed Sothoron (Lexington, MD)** played the next 19:21, made five saves and allowed two goals. **Chris Collins (Yorktown, NY)** of the University of Delaware made 10 saves and allowed seven goals over the final 20:12.

**Jay Pfeifer (Towson, MD)** of Syracuse University played the first half in goal for the North. He made three saves and allowed seven goals. The University at Albany's **Kevin Rae (Yorktown Heights, NY)** made seven saves and allowed seven goals in the second half.
