## **Cortland's Christina Acquaviva Named ECAC Division III Female Co-Field Athlete of the Week**

SUNY Cortland sophomore **Christina Acquaviva (Utica/Proctor)** has been selected as the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Division III Women's Outdoor Track and Field "Co-Field Athlete of the Week" for the week ending April 17. The award covers the entire ECAC region, which includes approximately 170 Division III schools from Maine to Maryland. Acquaviva shares the award with New Jersey City University's Andrea Herbert.

Acquaviva automatically qualified for the NCAA Division III Championships in the heptathlon with her third-place score of 4,596 points at the Bucknell University Bison Outdoor Classic last Friday and Saturday.

In the 100-meter hurdles portion of the event, she finished second with an NCAA provisional qualifying time of 14.49 seconds. She placed second in the long jump (ECAC-qualifying 17' 11.5"), was third in both the 200-meter dash (26.35) and high jump (5' 0.25") and was fourth in the javelin (105' 7").

Acquaviva will be making her second straight NCAA heptathlon appearance. She finished 11th in the seven-event competition at the national meet as a freshman last spring. This year's NCAA Division III Championships will be hosted May 26-28 by Wartburg College in Waverly, Iowa.
