## SUNY Cortland Women's Outdoor Track and Field

**at ECAC Division III Championships**

Thursday-Friday, May 19-20, 2005; Springfield College; Springfield, Mass.

SPRINGFIELD, MASS. – Cortland finished eighth in a group of 50 schools that scored points at the ECAC Division III Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championships, hosted by Springfield College. The Red Dragons scored 35 points, only three points from the third-place team in a tightly-contested meet. Oneonta won the title with 48 points.

Sophomore **Christina Acquaviva (Utica/Proctor)** led the Red Dragons with a second place finish in the 100-meter hurdles (14.68) and a third-place effort in the long jump (18' 1.75"). The 4x100-meter relay team of senior **Jackie Ferrentino (Buffalo/West Seneca East)**, Acquaviva, freshman **Ashley Wirges (Hopewell Junction/Arlington)** and sophomore **Jamie Ross (Ballston Lake/Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake)** finished third (49.10).

Senior **Betsy Schultz (Akron)** improved on her own school record in the 3,000-meter steeplechase with her fourth-place time of 11:18.35.

Other Red Dragons earning All-ECAC honors with their top-eight finishes were junior **Megan Kelley (Newburgh/Walkkill)** and sophomore **Tiffany Lancaster (Ballston Lake/Shenendehowa)**, who tied for fourth in the pole vault (10' 0"), and Ross in the 400 meters (seventh, 58.99).
