

## **SUNY Cortland Graduate International Student Costs 2009 Entry**

The following is a schedule of the annual costs to attend the State University of New York College at Cortland for an academic year. Students are billed on a semester basis, and these costs are subject to change.

### **Billed Costs (estimated)**

Tuition	\$9,936.00
Mandatory fees (includes mandatory international student health insurance)	\$ <u>1,648.00</u>

### **Additional Non-Billed Costs (estimated)**

Room and meals	\$9,170.00
Books & supplies	\$ 800.00
Personal expenses	\$1,500.00

### **Total Annual Costs (estimated)**

**\$23,854.00**

Please be aware that the above costs may vary from student to student. As an example, some students may spend more money on personal expenses or travel within the USA. Also, these costs do not include a variety of expenses such travel to and from a student's home country.

These costs should be used as the minimum amount of assured support available for each year of study when completing Part II of the Foreign Student Financial Statement (FSA-4). The total amount of assured support from personal, family, or other sponsor funds must be at least **\$23,854**. One year's worth of this assured support must be verified before a Form I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant (F-1) Student Status) can be issued.

Please review the second page of the FSA-4 for the required documentation to verify the assured support.

Bank verification statements must illustrate that funds are available in liquid assets. The statements must be dated within six months of the time the college will review them prior to issuing the Form I-20. Salary statements and property statements cannot be used as a means of support.

SUNY Cortland reserves the right to require additional financial documents from applicants to assist in the verification of assured support. Applicants will be notified if additional documents are needed after they have submitted completed applications.

Financial aid is only available to U.S. citizens and permanent residents.
