### Metcalfe Endowment Keynote Speaker: Fran P. Mainella



Fran Mainella is a visiting scholar at Clemson University Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism Management. Previously, Fran Mainella completed nearly six years as the 16th Director of the National Park Service and was the first woman to lead the National Park Service.

Fran is currently a member of Newsweek Magazine's Environmental Advisory Board, a board member of the National Society for Park Resources, a fellow of the American Academy for Park and Recreation Administration, a member of the Advisory Board for the Children and Nature Network, and a national speaker on parks and recreation.

Former Director Mainella holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Connecticut, a master's degree, and an honorary doctorate from Central Connecticut State College.
