Dartfish Training & Certification Course Descriptions



Dartfish Power User Training & Certification Course

Description: The Dartfish Power User training and certification is a second level course designed to educate students on an advanced level on digital video analysis and Dartfish software and hardware. Students will attend eight hours of training over the course of two days and will be able to demonstrate an advanced understanding of the software and hardware processes used to shoot, capture, analyze and distribute digital video using Dartfish. The following topics will be covered: Advanced Analyzer Module, Advanced Dartfish Output & Sharing, Advanced StroMotion Module, Advanced SimulCam Module and Advanced Tagging Module. A Dartfish techniques question and answer session with experts will be held during the last hour on day one. Students are encouraged to bring previous Dartfish video analysis projects and/or media books with them. Participants will also have access to SUNY Cortland's student technology core for support for six months after training.

Required Knowledge: Previous experience with the Windows operating system is required. Previous experience with digital video filming and analysis is required. Students must have completed the Dartfish Video Coach Training Course to enroll.

Certification: The Dartfish Power User Certification exam is available for students to take at the end of the course. Certification exams are also given at the end of each semester in the Sport Media & Technology Learning Center on campus. The cost is \$75 per attempt. A grade of 85 percent or higher is considered a passing grade. 75 percent of the test is practical and 25 percent of the exam is written. Official certificates will be issued to all students who pass the exam.

Cost: \$395 per person. A 10 percent discount will be given to organizations who sign up five or more for a training session. Payments are accepted via the Dartfish Web site at www.buydartfish.com.

Refresher Course: This course is for student who would like to take the Dartfish Power User training course a second time. The cost is \$250 per person. A 10 percent discount will be given to organizations who sign up five or more for a training session.

Location: All Dartfish Power User training courses will be held in the Sport Media & Technology Learning Center in the Studio West Building on the campus of the State University of New York at Cortland.
