**Dartfish Training & Certification Course Descriptions**



**Dartfish Sport/Discipline Specific Training Seminar**

**Description:** The Dartfish Sport/Discipline Specific training seminar is designed to provide students with in-depth practical knowledge of Dartfish software and hardware practices in a specific sport or academic discipline. The course includes case studies, best practices and applied Dartfish fieldwork in a specific sport or discipline. The course covers two days and six hours of instruction. In addition, at least one current expert Dartfish user in the sport or discipline will be present at the end of day one for an hour-long question and answer session.

**Required Knowledge:** Previous experience with the Windows operating system is required. Previous experience with digital video filming and analysis is required. Students must have completed the Dartfish Level I Training Course to enroll.

**Certification:** The Dartfish Sport/Discipline Specific Certification exam is available for students to take at the end of the course. Certification exams are also given at the end of each semester in the Sport Media & Technology Learning Center on campus. The cost is \$75 per attempt. A grade of 85 percent or higher is considered a passing grade. 75 percent of the test is practical and 25 percent of the exam is written. Official certificates will be issued to all students who pass the exam.

**Cost:** \$395 per person. A 10 percent discount will be given to organizations who sign up five or more for a training session. Payments are accepted via the Dartfish Web site at [www.buydartfish.com](http://www.buydartfish.com).

**Location:** All Dartfish Sport/Discipline Specific training seminars will be held in the Sport Media & Technology Learning Center in the Studio West Building and in the athletic facilities on the campus of the State University of New York at Cortland.
